Alaska Pink Salmon Outlook & Summary

Market Commentary

Alaska's pink salmon harvest is expected to rebound to normal levels after a disappointing 2018. If Alaska and Russia forecasts are realized, an elevated global supply of pink salmon could push prices lower. Trade disputes with China (an important reprocessing market for pinks) also presents risks to the industry. While Alaska H&G volume will be competing with Russian supply, anecdotal reports indicate canned production from the state is positioned favorably in the market.


