# 2020 Alaska Chinook Salmon Outlook & Summary

#### **Market Commentary**

The anticipated 2020 harvest of 320,000 Chinook salmon represents a third year of growing harvest if realized. Even with this increase, landings for the species would be low compared to historical data. Most production goes to the domestic market, with significant exposure to the high-end market. Due primarily to disruptions associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, market prices are expected to be down in 2020. A lower ex-vessel price for Prince William Sound Chinook is an early indicator of market weakness.
