- Early season Bristol Bay harvests are in line with pre-season predictions of significant decline. The Nushagak district makes up 67% of total Bristol Bay harvest YTD, with Egegik following at 18%.
- Prices for Copper River fish are starting to decline amid high early season harvest of chinook and sockeye. Prices for sockeye declined from \$7 per pound during the first opener of the season to \$2.50 per pound in early June.
- Early season keta harvests remain down year-over-year despite high keta run predictions. Prince William Sound produced over 37% of total statewide keta harvest to date.
- Total statewide harvest across all species has reached 6% of the predicted total run of 135.6 million fish, with sockeye making up 72% of all salmon harvested to date.

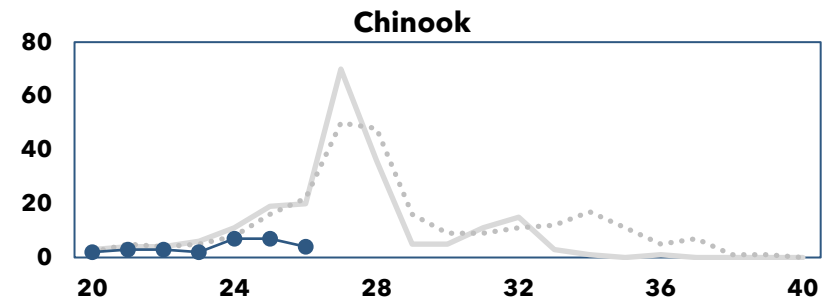
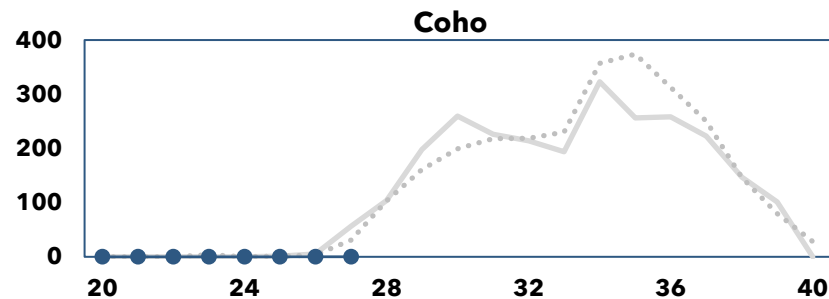
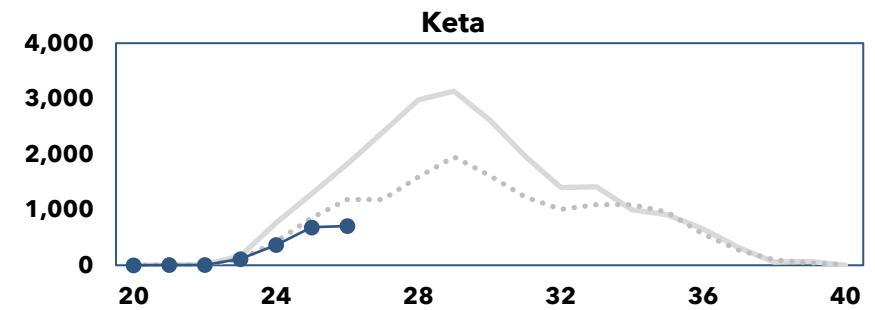
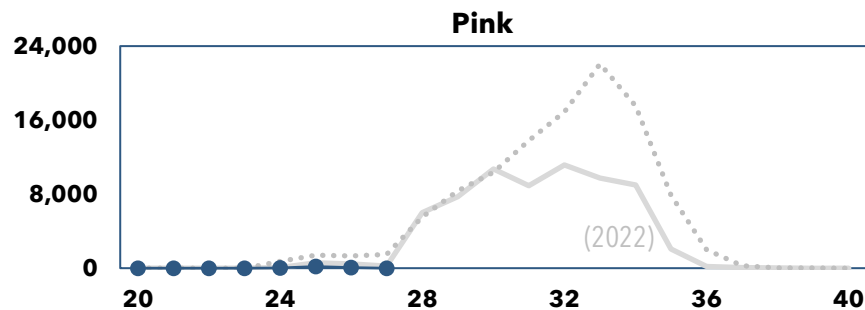
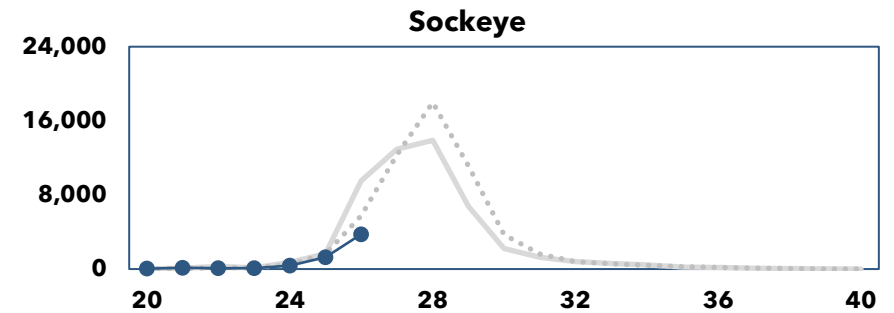
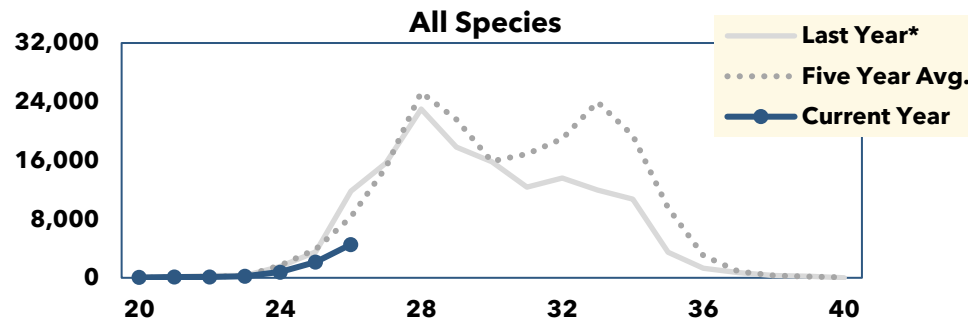
